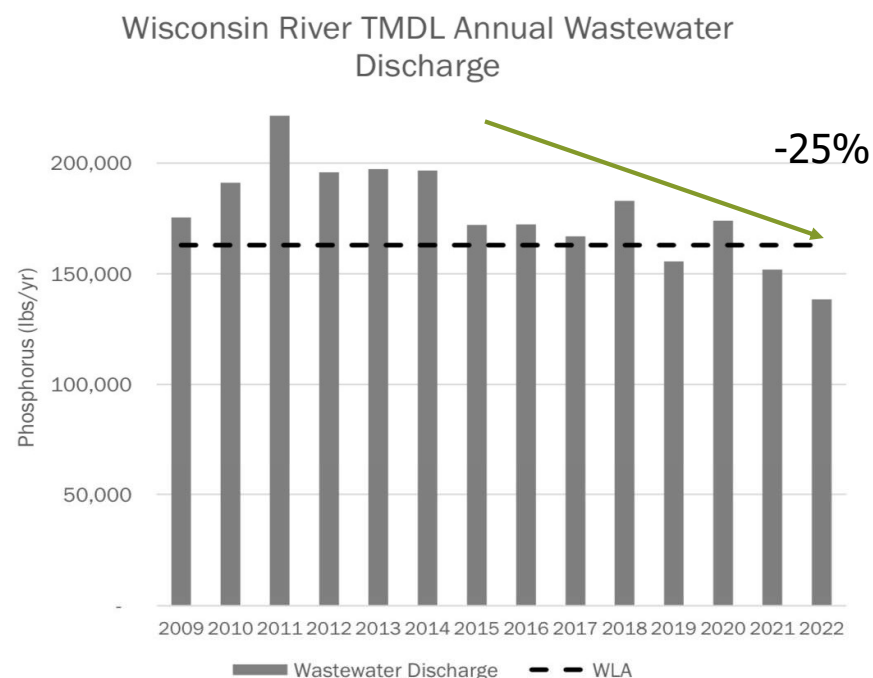

Wastewater

- 73 out of 106 permits issued under the TMDL
 - Half of facilities discharged below their WLA in 2022
- Vast majority of permittees still pursuing traditional “brick & mortar” compliance options
- A handful permittees engaged in watershed alternatives (pre and post TMDL)
- Multi-discharger variance being used by ~20% of permittees



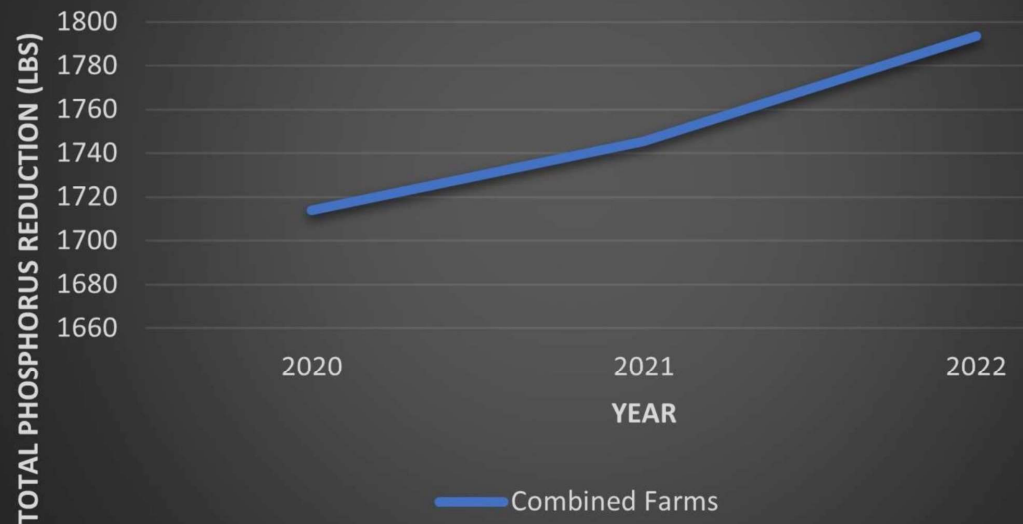
