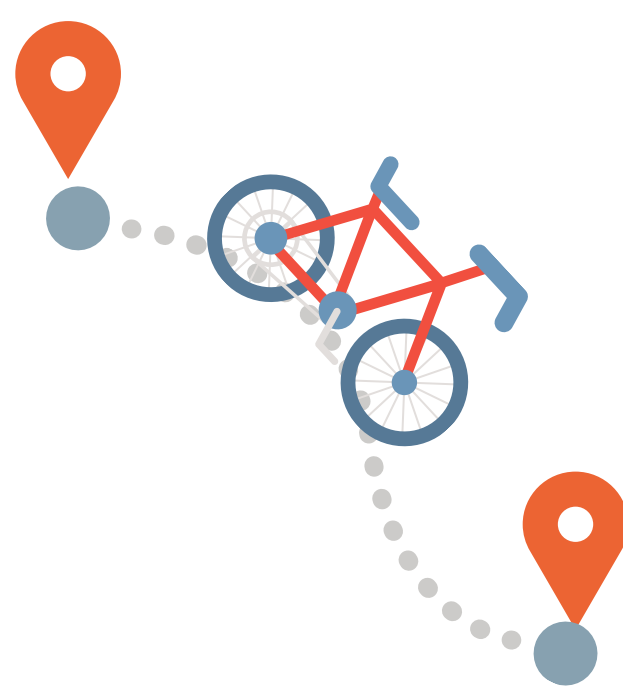
NEED A BIKE?
